

Prof. Yuri Grigoriev PhD is a medical scientist specializing in radiation biology, and a senior researcher of the Federal Medical Biophysics Centre, the Russian Federation. He is the President of the Russian National Committee on Non-Ionizing Radiation Protection (RNCNIRP), a member of the Bureau of the Scientific Council on Radiobiology of the Russian Academy of Sciences, a member of the Russian Scientific Commission on radiation protection, a permanent member of the International consulting Committee of the WHO on Electromagnetic Fields and Public Health, and a member of the Editorial board of the Russian Journal Radiation Biology (Radioecology). Prof. Yuri Grigoriev's area of research focuses on the biological action of ionizing and non-ionizing radiation and evaluation of the hazards of action of physical factors on populations. He is the founder of a school for experts in the radiobiology of ionizing and non-ionizing radiation, extreme physiology and hygiene. He has mentored more than 70 doctorate scientists and is the author of 21 monographic books and more than 400 peer-reviewed papers, published in national and international journals
